3. Consent

4. Disclosure

Codub Consulting will not pass on your personal data to third parties without first obtaining your consent.

Retention period

Codub Consulting will process personal data for the duration of the service contract with the data subjects organisation (Codub Consulting's customer) or only for the duration that the data subject is employed by the organisation (Codub Consulting's customer) and will store the personal data for no longer than 5 years.

5. Your rights as a data subject

At any point while we are in possession of or processing your personal data, you, the data subject, have the following rights:

- Right of access you have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you.
- Right of rectification you have a right to correct data that we hold about you that is inaccurate or incomplete.
- Right to be forgotten in certain circumstances you can ask for the data we hold about you to be erased from our records.

- Right of portability you have the right to have the data we hold about you transferred to another organisation.
- Right to object you have the right to object to certain types of processing such as direct marketing.

6. Online privacy statement

Personal data

How will Codub Consulting use the personal data it collects about me?

Codub Consulting will process (collect, store and use) the information you provide in a manner compatible with the EU's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We will endeavour to keep your information accurate and up to date, and not keep it for longer than is necessary. Codub Consulting is required to retain information in accordance with the law, such as information needed for income tax and audit purposes. How long certain kinds of personal data should be kept may also be governed by specific business-sector requirements and agreed practices. Personal data may be held in addition to these periods depending on individual business needs.

Under what circumstances will Codub Consulting contact me?

Our aim is not to be invasive, and we undertake not to ask irrelevant or unnecessary questions. Moreover, the information you provide will be subject to rigorous measures and procedures to minimise the risk of unauthorised access or disclosure.

Can I find out the personal data that the organisation holds about me?
